### CHELSEA HELMS

Chelsea Helms is the main evening anchor for CBS4 in Central Indiana. She grew up on the Canadian border in New York but came to the Circle City by way of Fayetteville Arkansas, where she spent about six years at KNWA News. As the main anchor she covered several significant stories. In 2023, she was named “Outstanding New Journalist” by the Arkansas Pro Chapter of the Society of Professional Journalists. Her work has also received several awards from the organization, and she’s been nominated for multiple Emmy awards, including one for a five-part series on the 20th anniversary of September 11th.



### DANIEL MILLER

Three-time Emmy award winning journalist Daniel Miller anchors FOX59 Morning News from 7-10 a.m. with Angela Ganote. He joined FOX59 in January 2021 after six years in Boston as a morning anchor at the FOX affiliate, WFXT-TV. Miller is no stranger to Indianapolis and the Hoosier state — in 2015, before taking the job in New England, he was a weekend evening anchor/reporter for WISH-TV. Daniel has been recognized by the Indiana Broadcasters Association for Breaking News Coverage during severe weather. He’s also a member of the National Association of Black Journalists and Lambda Chi Alpha Fraternity.

The two-time Emmy award winner is honored to call Indiana home. Previously, Bearshelle worked as a weekend morning anchor for WNCN-TV in Raleigh, North Carolina, where she earned several awards. Bearshelle has also worked at WDTN-TV in Dayton, Ohio and KMEG-TV and KPTH-TV in the tri-state region of Iowa, Nebraska and South Dakota. A proud native of Philadelphia, Bearshelle is an alumna of Loyola University Maryland and a member of the National Association of Black Journalists.



### LINDY THACKSTON

Lindy Thackston anchors FOX59 Morning News weekdays from 4 to 7 a.m. She’s been with FOX59 since October 2013. While not in the newsroom, Lindy is an emcee for Indiana Pacers games and a trackside announcer at the Indianapolis Motor Speedway for the IMS PA team. Lindy has spent more than 16 years covering news, sports and entertainment. She has been an anchor and reporter at various stations, including WLFI-TV in Lafayette, Indiana, WSIL-TV in southern Illinois and First Coast News in Jacksonville, Florida. She is the winner of two Edward R. Murrow awards and several Associated Press Awards.



# JONATHAN ELIAS

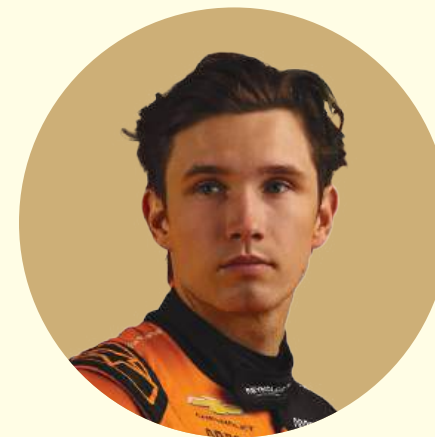

Born into a racing family in Hedensted, Denmark, Christian kicked off his professional karting journey at 11 years old and showed his prowess from a young age. His career quickly took off as he won multiple major championships throughout European karting competition.

Christian made the jump to single-seater racing in 2017 when he debuted in the Spanish F4 Championship and the SMP F4 Championship at 15 years old. He then competed in the GP3 Series Championship in 2018 where he finished second in the standings.

Christian emerged as an Alpine development driver competing in the 2019 FIA Formula 3 Championship, where he produced a win, two podiums and two poles. He then made the jump to the FIA Formula 2 Championship under Alpine support, where he registered two wins and nine podiums across the 2020-21 seasons.

He next shifted gears to the North American motorsports scene where he made an immediate splash as the 2022 NTT INDYCAR SERIES Rookie of the Year with Rahal Letterman Lanigan, with which he raced through his first three seasons in the series.

In 2025, Christian completed his first season with Arrow McLaren, piloting the No. 7 Arrow McLaren Chevrolet to six podiums and a career-best fifth place finish in the championship.

Christian, 24, has produced a strong start to his NTT INDYCAR SERIES career, boasting a win on the streets of Toronto in 2023, three pole positions and nine podiums.

Beyond racing, Christian’s passion for golf keeps him busy, from competing in Pro-Am appearances to attending major tournaments.
